Dr Lars Lannfelt, Senior Professor of Geriatrics, Uppsala University

Lars Lannfelt and his group detected the "Swedish" mutation leading to 3-5 times increase of amyloid 6 and the "Arctic" mutation generating soluble aggregated A6 protofibrils. Lars Lannfelt is a cofounder of the company BioArctic that developed the antibody lecanemab selectively targeting A6 protofibrils, now in phase 3 clinical development.
